Real courage means standing for truth even when it's uncomfortable. It means being ready with thoughtful answers when people ask tough questions.






It means refusing to compromise

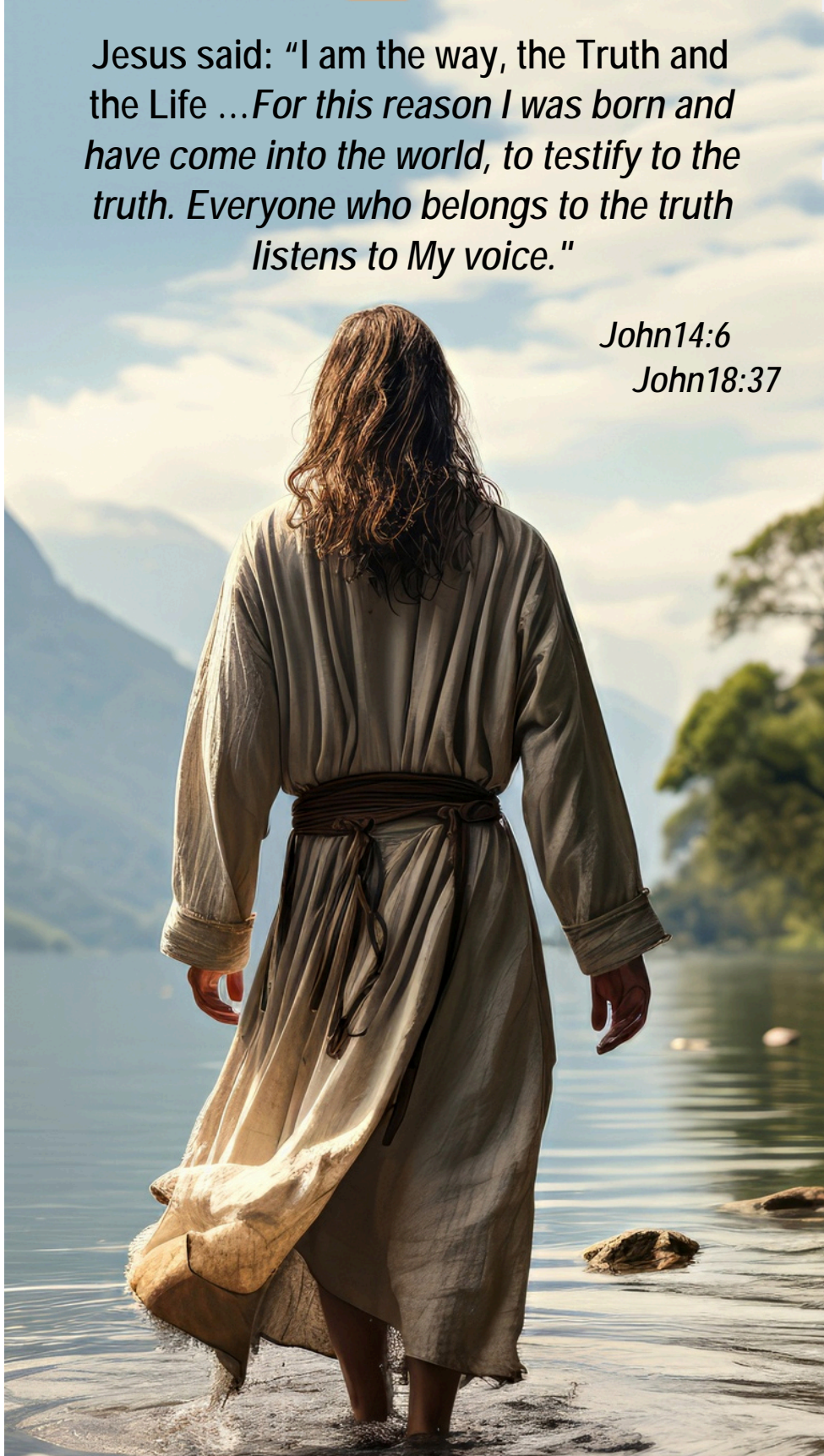
