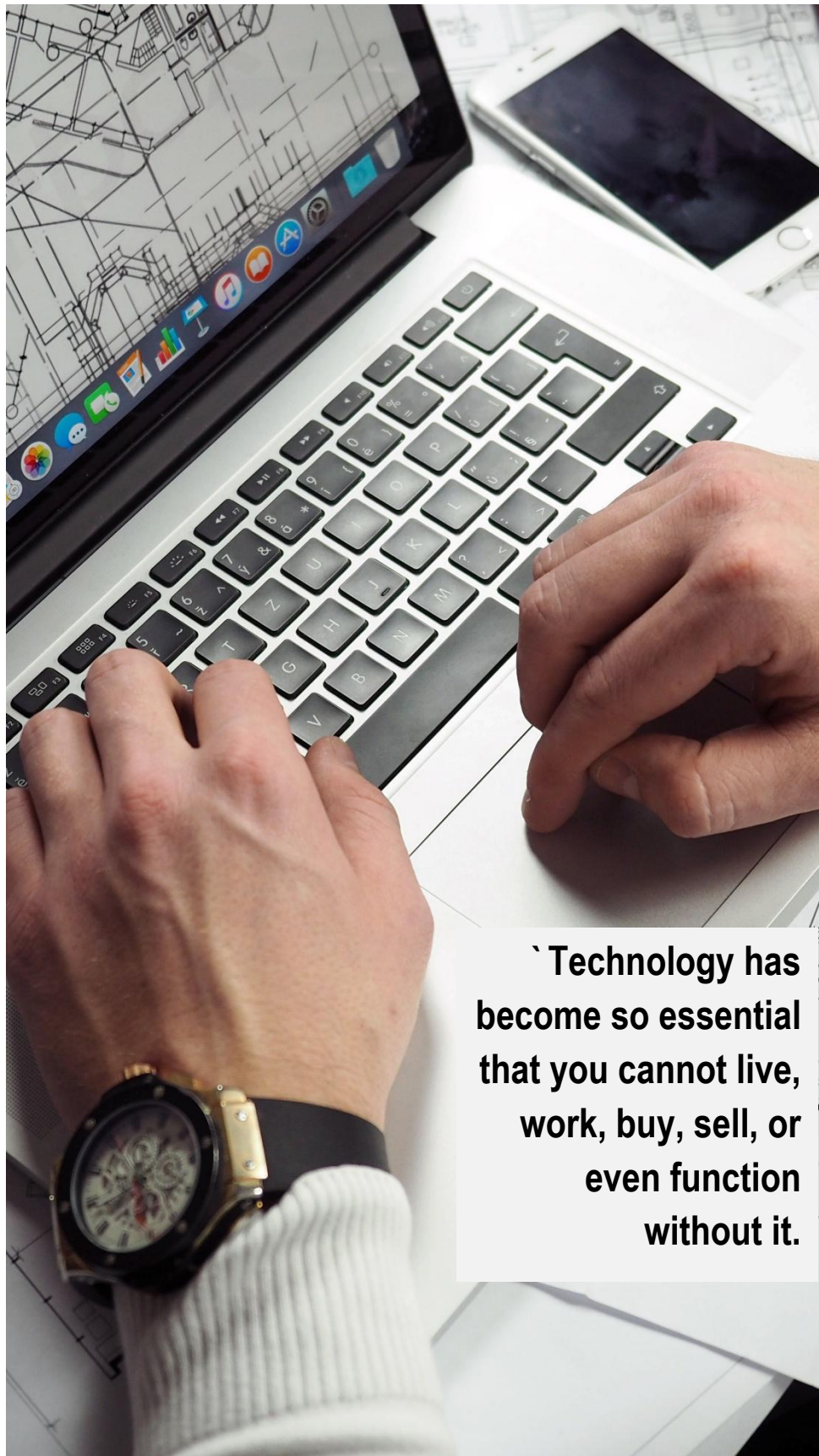


Who Is in Control?



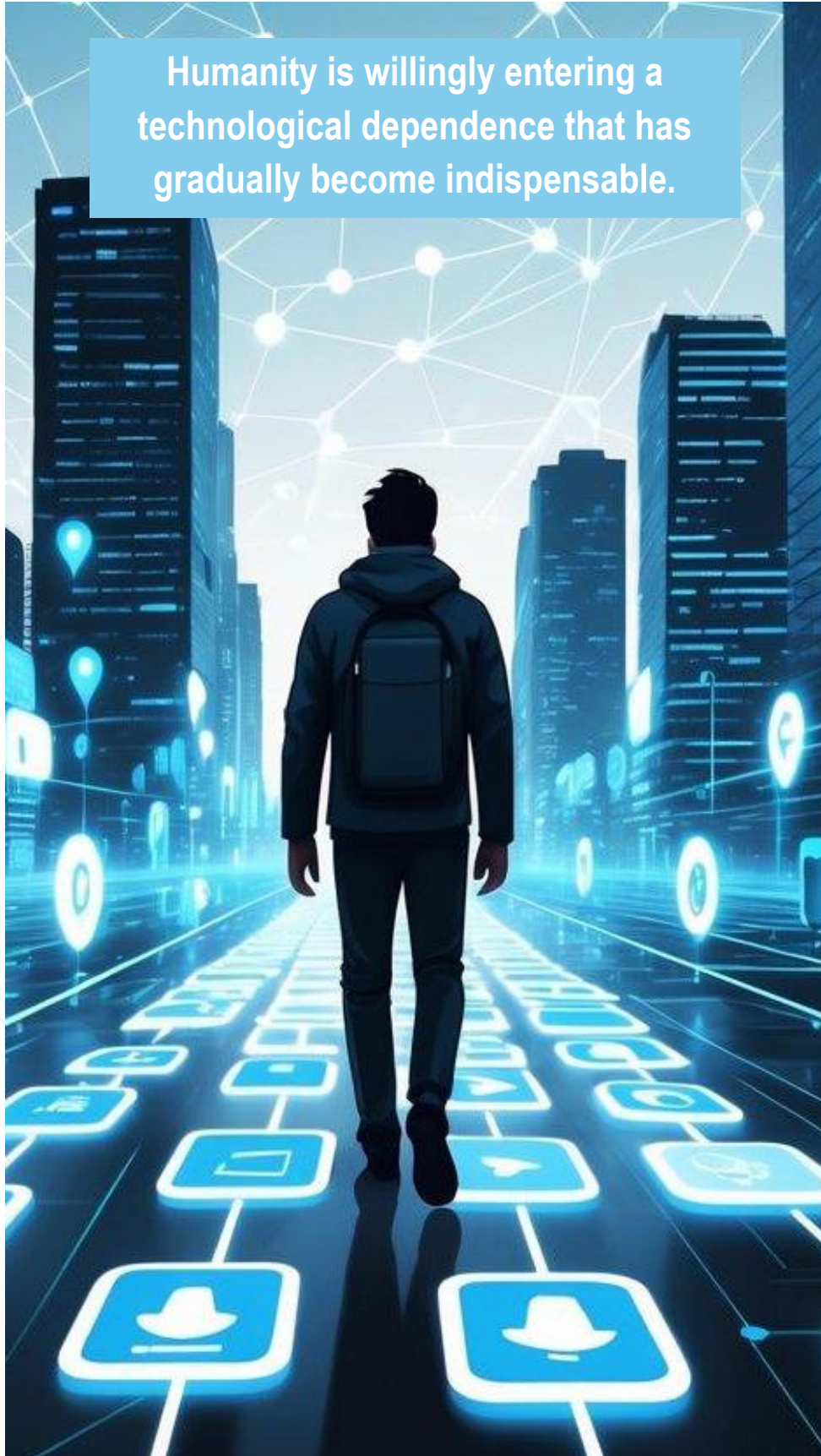


**` Technology has

` We give it our information, our creativity, our opinions—even intimate details of our lives. Technology has become inseparable from us.



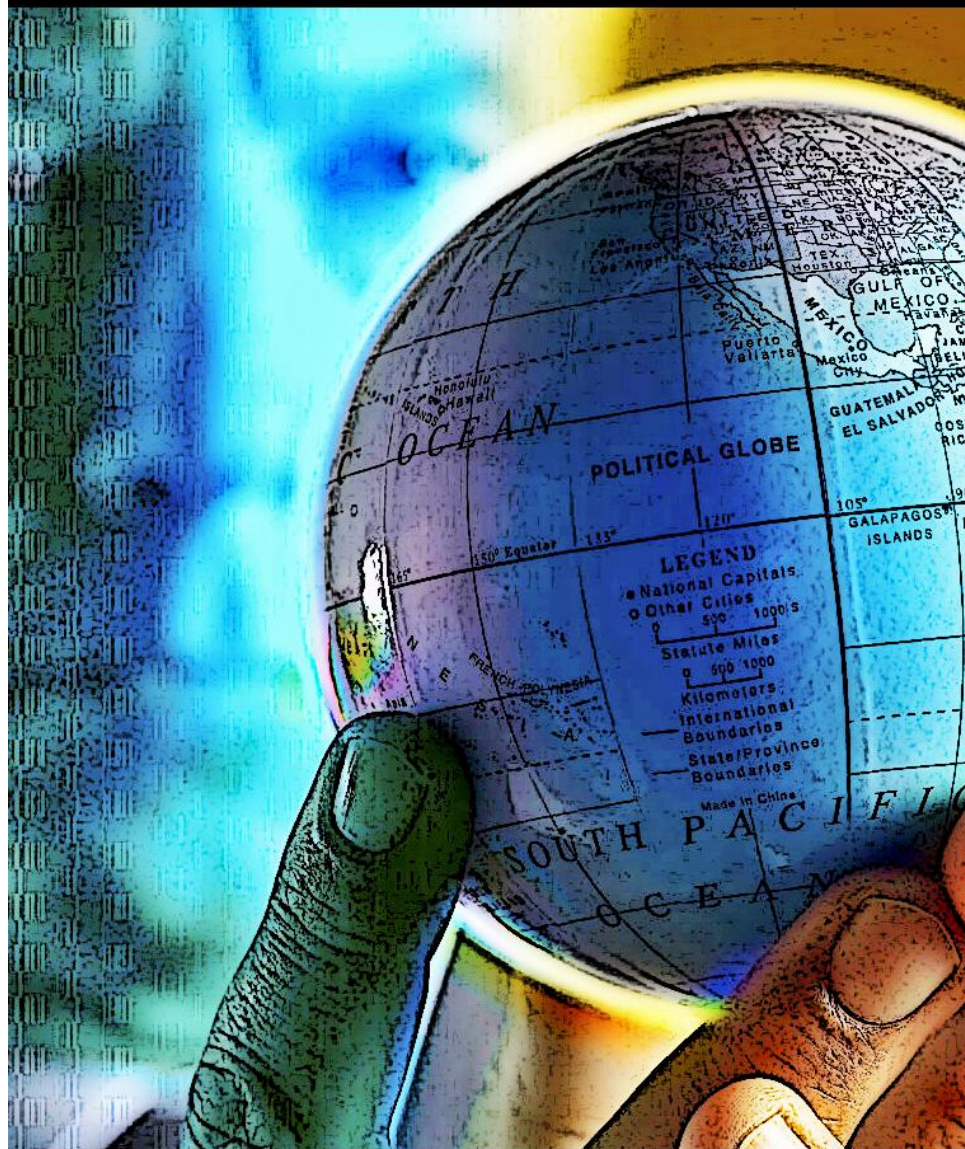
**` Does the Bible address this? Revelation

described as “the Beast.”**



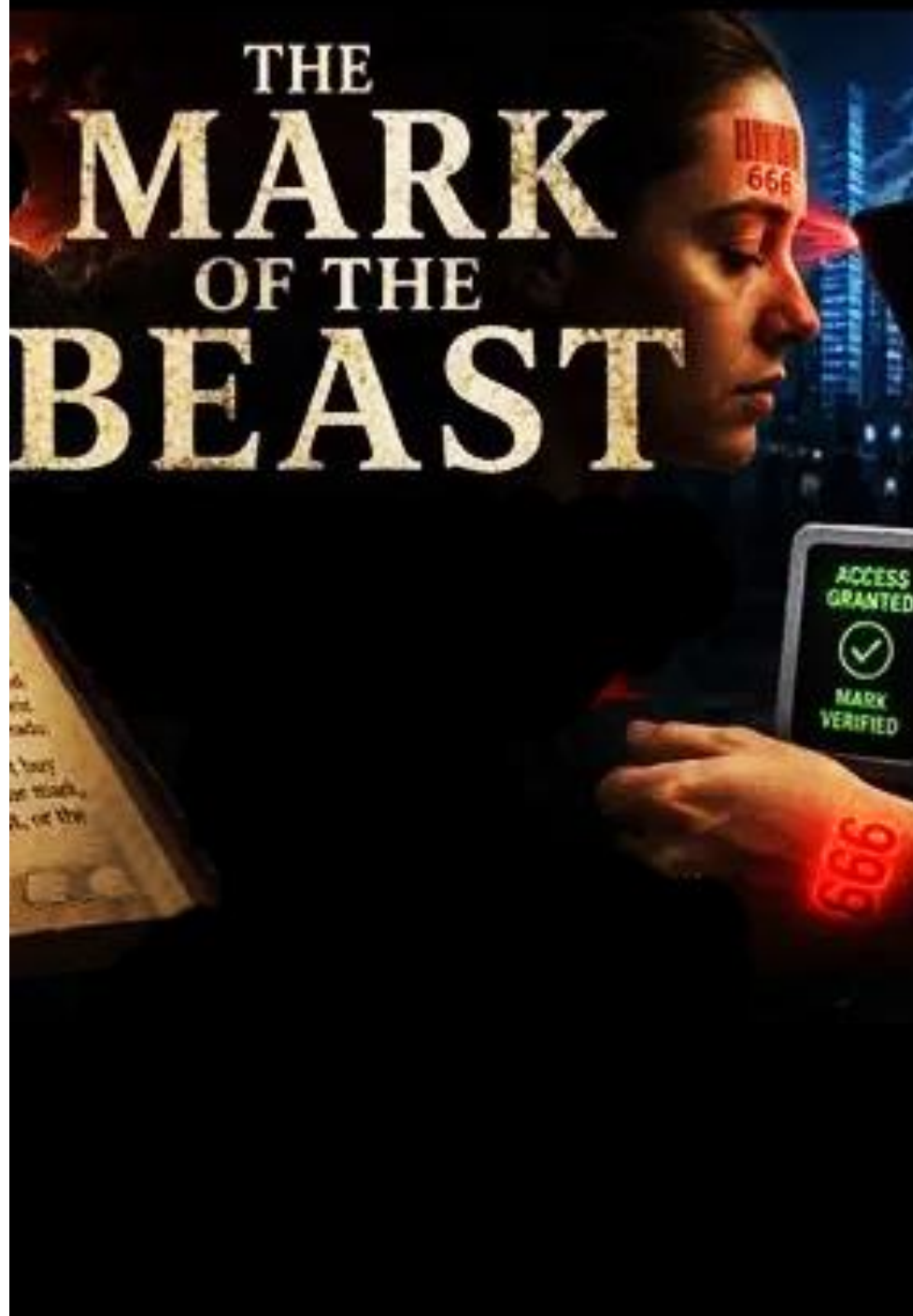
REVELATION

Chapter 13

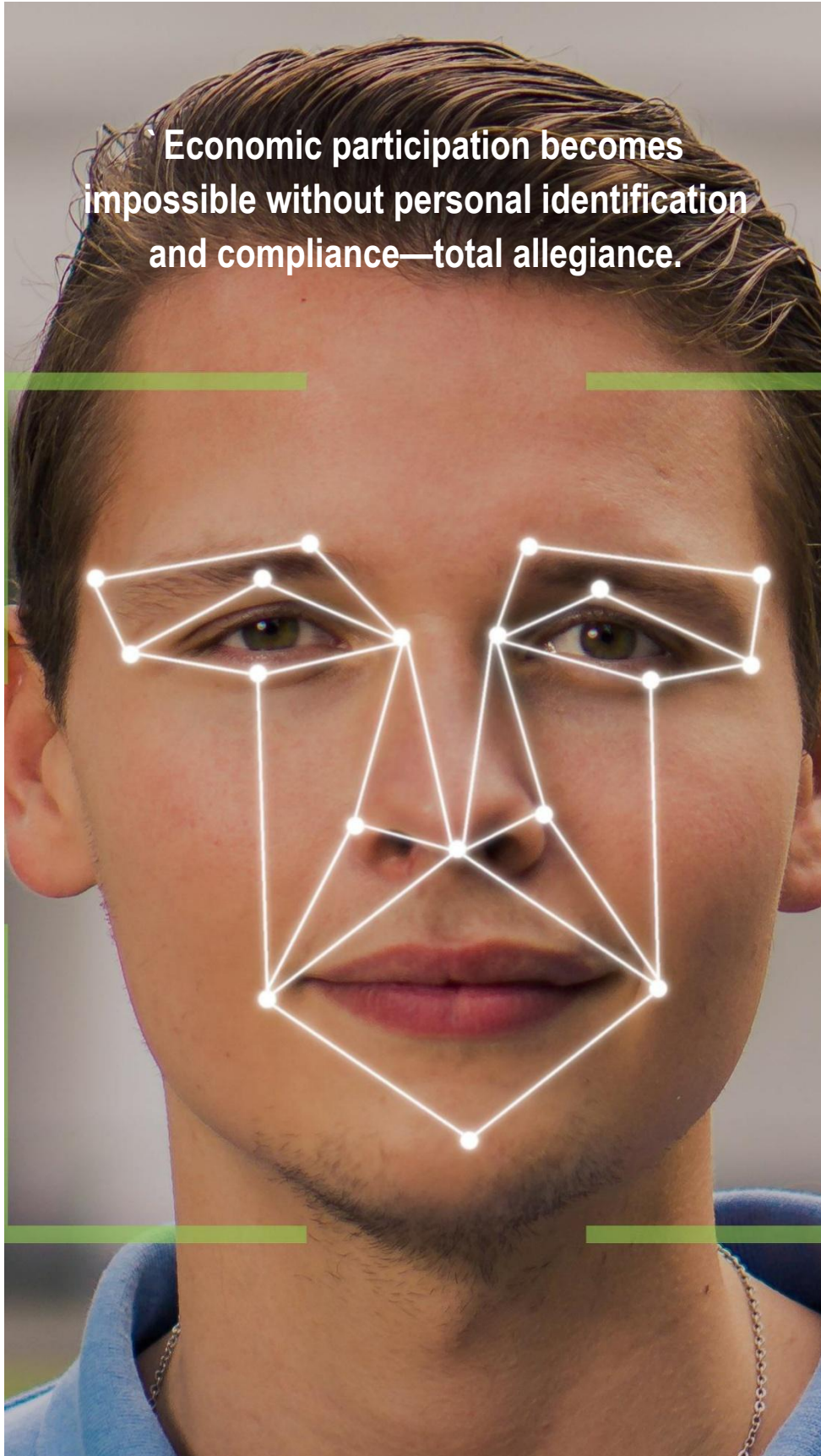
He and his regime will exercise enormous power over humanity. But then comes something astonishing:

· Economic participation becomes impossible without personal identification and compliance—total allegiance.



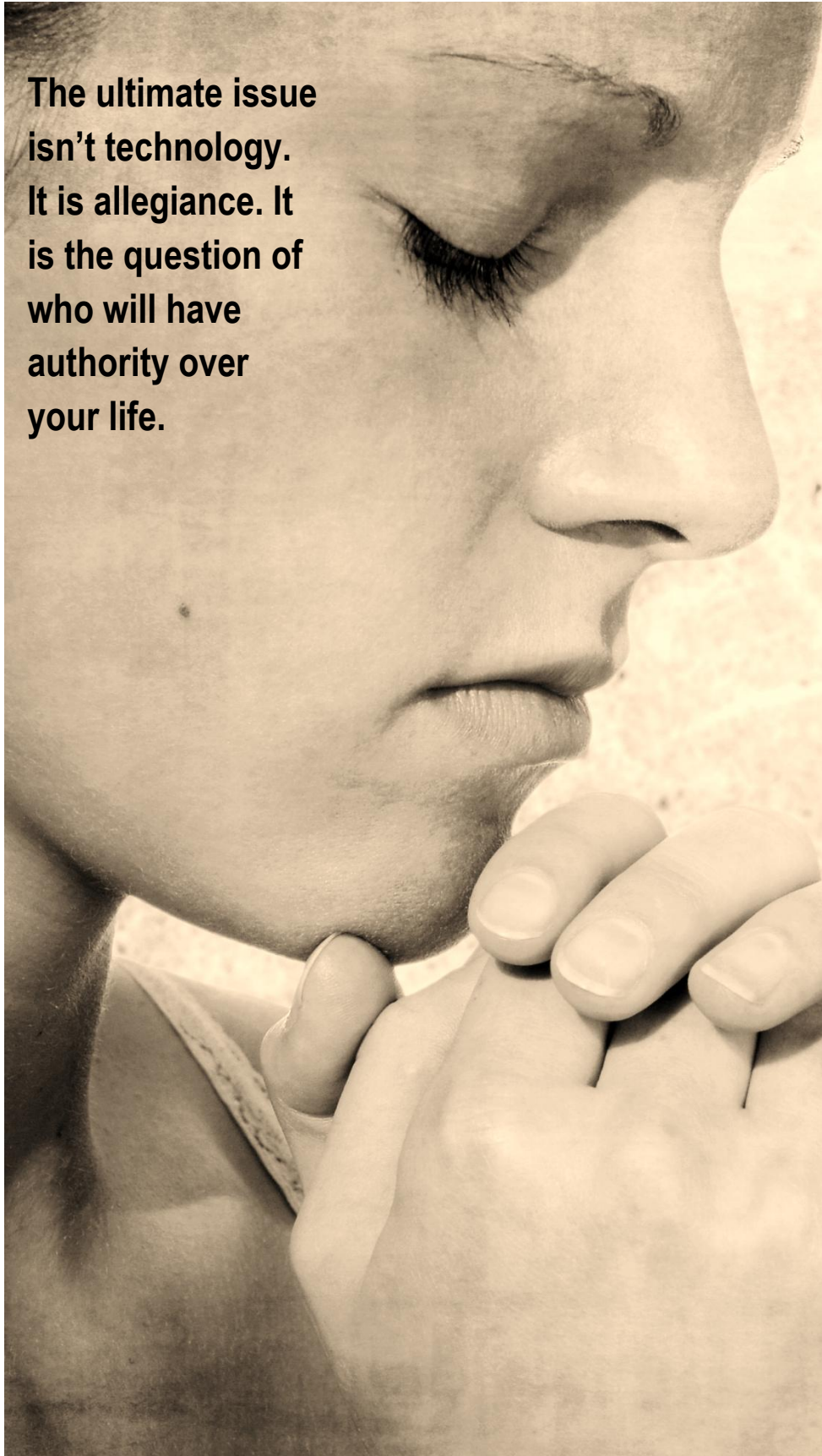
Revelation also describes “an image of the Beast” that is somehow given the ability to speak and exercise authority—even to kill those who rebel.

your life.**



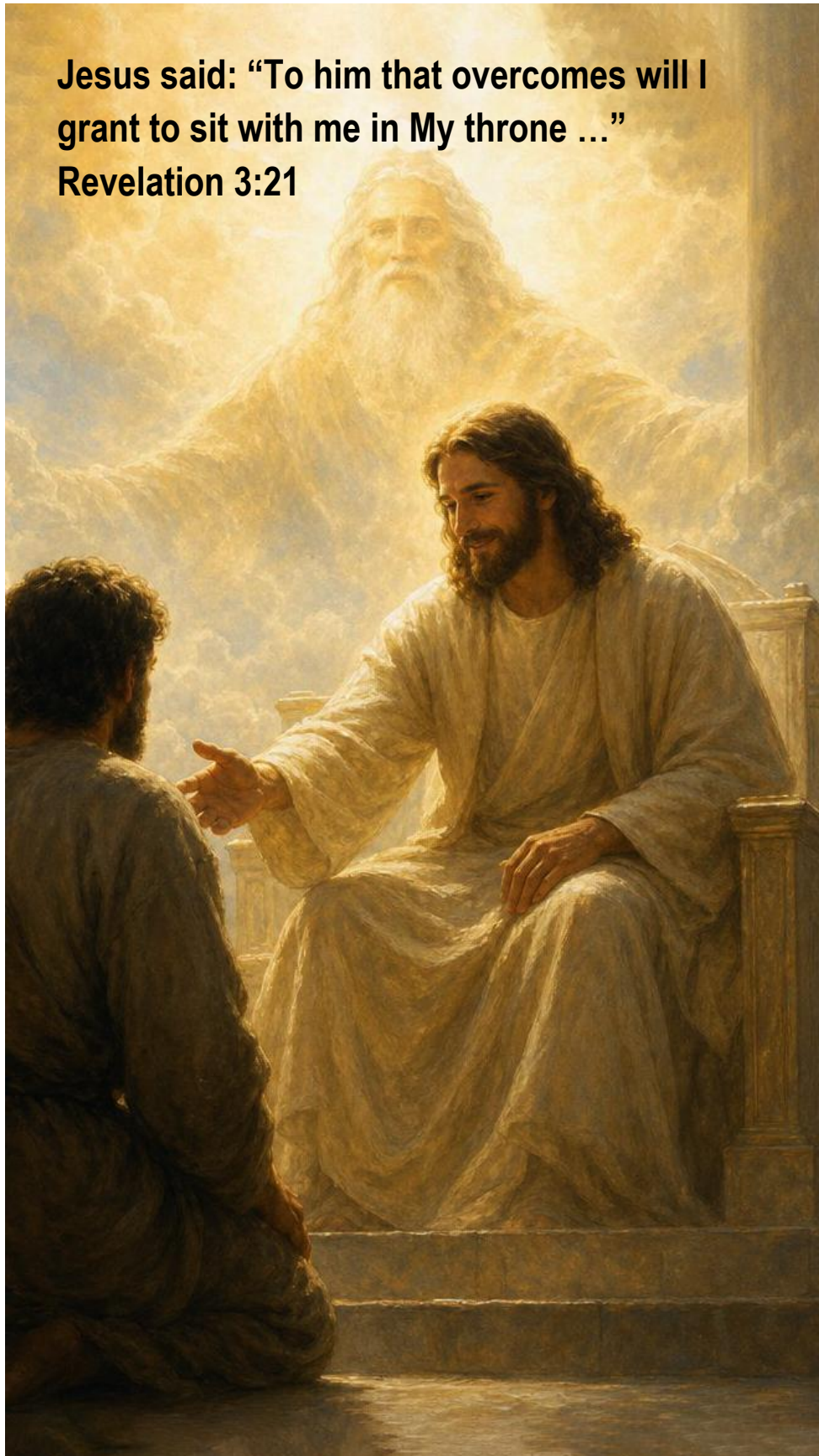
The time is coming when the world will be
